Please note:

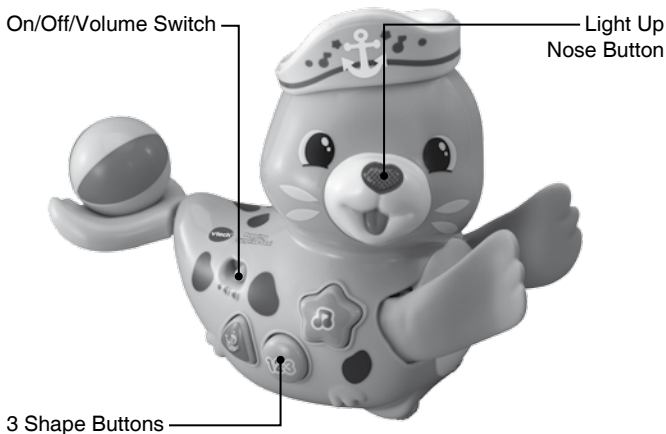
This is not a bath toy. Do not submerge or expose the seal to water.

When the seal launches it's ball into the air please ensure you are an appropriate distance away to avoid the ball coming too close to people's faces and eyes.

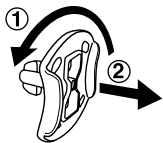
WARNING:

All packing materials such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks, removable tags, cable ties, cords and packaging screws are not part of this toy and should be discarded for your child's safety.

Removing the packaging locks:

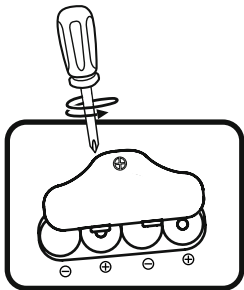


- ① Rotate the packaging locks anticlockwise 90 degrees.
- ② Pull out the packaging locks and discard.

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the electronic module. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and open the battery cover.
3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one side of each battery.
4. Install 4 new AA batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of a new alkaline battery is recommended for maximum performance).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metal-hydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

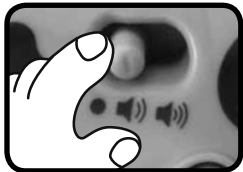

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Switch** to the **Low Volume**  or **High Volume**  position. You will hear a song, phrase and fun sound. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Volume Switch** to the **Off**  position.



2. Light Up Nose Button

The Light Up Nose Button will teach the colour of the seal's nose, introduce the seal, and play playful songs and melodies.

3. Three Shape Buttons

The Three Shape Buttons introduce the seal, numbers, colours, shapes, and play playful songs and melodies.

4. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the Popping Surprise Seal will automatically power down after approximately 50 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

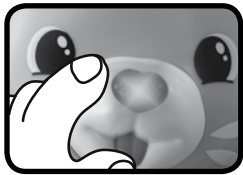
Note:

This product is in Try Me mode in the packaging. After opening the package, turn the unit off and on again to proceed with normal play. If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Light Up Nose Button

Press the **Light Up Nose Button** to learn about the colour of seal's nose and to play playful songs and melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.



2. Shape Buttons

Press the **Shape Buttons** to learn colours, shapes, numbers, to introduce the seal, and to play playful songs and melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.



3. Magic Sensor

Put the ball on the seal's tail, then see the ball launch up into the hat. The **Magic Sensor** on Seal's hat can recognise the ball and will play fun phrases and sound effects. Seal will also, move forward and clap his hands.



Note:

If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing, please install a new set of batteries.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.

3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Please turn the unit Off.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit On. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
