## Pet Battery Installation


Battery installation should be performed by an adult


- 1. Pull back the plush flap located on the bottom of the pet. (See Fig. 1)
- 2. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screw and battery compartment cover. (See Fig. 2)
- Insert three (3) AAA batteries (not included) with the positive (+) and negative (-) ends facing the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- 4. Replace the battery compartment cover and tighten the screw
- 5. Move the "ON/OFF/TRY ME" switch to ON.
- 6. Replace the plush flap covering the battery area.


### Clock Battery Installation

Battery installation should be performed by an adult.

- and battery compartment cover on the back of the clock.
- Insert one (1) button cell CR2032 battery with the positive (+) and negative (-) ends facing the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment. (See Fig. 3)
- 3. Replace the battery compartment cover and tighten the screw.
- 4. Set the clock using the procedures listed later in this manual.

#### YOUR RESCUE PET NAME STICKER

Once you have named your Rescue Pet  $^{TM}$ , write the name on the sticker provided,

- 1. Open the front of the clock.
- 2. Peel the sticker off its backing.
- 3. Place the sticker on the inside of the Clock cover (See Fig. 4) and close the clock cover.

#### TO SELECT MODE FOR PETS:

Slide the ON/OFF/TRY ME switch to the ON position (See Fig.1) NOTE: In TRY ME mode, press the left paw and your pet will sit up, bark, move its head from side to side and wag its tail. Also, the Alarm function is disabled in this mode.

#### SETTING THE CLOCK

Before setting the clock, remove the tab from the back side of the clock by pulling it out completely. This will activate the clock.

### SETTING THE TIME (See Figs. 4 to 6)


- Press the "Mode" button (until "AL" is not shown in the center of the display) to select the Clock display mode.
- 2. Press "Set" once and the hour will flash.
- 3. Press "Inc" until you reach the hour you wish.
- 4. Press "Set" again and the minutes will flash.
- 5. Press "Inc" until you reach the minutes you wish.
- 6. Press "Set" again to confirm the time you have chosen.


NOTE: "PM" will show on the left side of the display for afternoon. If the left side of the display is blank in the same area, the clock is in "AM" mode.


#### SETTING THE ALARM


- 1. Turn the Alarm Switch to OFF position.
- Press the "Mode" button (until "AL" appear in the center of the display) to select the Alarm display mode.
- 3. Press "Set" once and the hour will flash
- 4. Press "Inc" until you reach the hour you wish.
- 5. Press "Set" again and the minutes will flash.
- 6. Press "Inc" until you reach the minutes you wish.
- 7. Press "Set" again to confirm the Alarm time you have chosen.
- 8. Turn the Alarm Switch to the ON position to activate the alarm function. (A Bell icon will appear on the display and, in a few seconds, the Rescue Pet™ will lie down.
- To turn the Alarm off, move the Alarm Switch to the OFF position. (The Bell icon will disappear from the display and the pet will sit up.)

NOTE: The Alarm function is disabled in TRY ME mode.











## QUICK START (con't)

- · After you have set the alarm, your Pet will lie down and sleep until it's time to wake you up.
- When it's time to wake you up, your Rescue Pet<sup>™</sup> will sit up, bark, wag its tail and move its head from side to side. (See Fias. 7 to 9)
- If you don't wish to get up right away, press the "snooze" area on your pet's forehead (See Fig. 9) and your pet will wait 5 minutes before it tries to wake you again. You may "snooze" 3 times.
- The fourth time you press the "snooze" will turn the alarm off.
- If you don't press the "snooze" area on your pet's forehead, it barks for 1 minute. After it stop barking, if you turn Alarm Switch from ON to OFF, then turn to ON again, your pet will lie down and go to sleep.







# SAFE BATTERY USAGE

- 1. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged;
- 2. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged;
- 3. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision;
- 4. Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed;
- 5. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used;
- 6. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity;
- 7 Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy;
- 8. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited;
- 9. Do not dispose the batteries in fire, batteries may leak or explode;
- 10. Batteries should be replaced by adult;
- 11. Use alkaline batteries for better performance.

# TROUBLESHOOTING

 If the motion of your Rescue Pet™ becomes slow and/or the voice becomes weak, replace the batteries with fresh AAA Alkaline batteries.

# CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

To clean your Pet, brush it with a cloth or soft brush to loosen any dirt. Then use a slightly damp cloth to remove any stains.

- DO NOT put your Pet into the washing machine.
- DO NOT use detergent or stain removers on the plush covering of the Pet.
- · DO NOT submerge your Pet in water.
