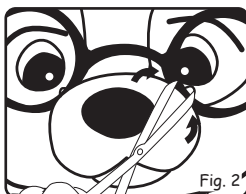
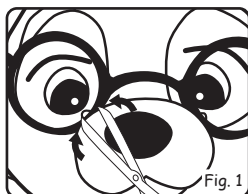

IMPORTANT OPERATING NOTES FOR PARENTS

- Study Buddy™ Koby™ currently speaks only English.
- Study Buddy™ Koby™ is best played with in a quiet room with low or no background noise.
- Best voice recognition will be achieved when children say the command words as listed in the manual.
- Study Buddy™ Koby™ may find it hard to understand children with speech difficulties.
- Ask your child to keep Study Buddy™ Koby™ at arms length while speaking with him.
- Ask your child to speak normally (don't yell) and wait for Study Buddy™ Koby™ to finish talking before the child begins to talk.
- When more than one child is playing with Study Buddy™ Koby™, only one child should speak to Koby™ at any one time.
- Do Not place bandanas or any other item around Study Buddy's™ Koby's neck as it may interfere with voice recognition.
- Study Buddy™ Koby™ will arrive wearing glasses. To remove the glasses for the first time, an adult must snip the threads holding the nose piece to Study Buddy™ Koby's face. Study Buddy™ Koby's glasses may then be removed and replaced by slipping the glasses earpieces into and out of the loops on each side of his head. (Figs. 1 to 3)

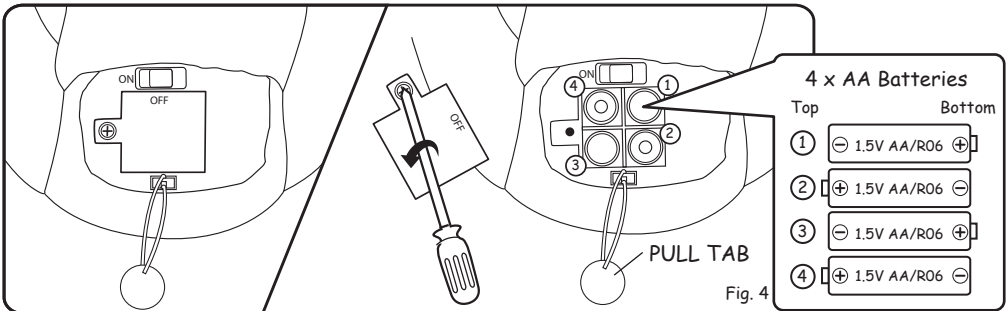


BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Before starting on a fun-filled journey to learning, find the "Try Me" tab on the underside of the Study Buddy™, pull it completely out and discard it.

NOTE: Batteries included are for in store demonstration only. Please change batteries when you take the product home before playing. You may wish to install fresh alkaline batteries for best results. To do so:

1. Open the Velcro™ closure on the bottom of the Study Buddy™.
2. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw(s) and battery compartment cover.
3. Install four (4) AA alkaline batteries making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartments. (Fig. 4)
4. Replace the battery compartment cover and tighten the screw(s).
5. Turn the ON/OFF switch to ON.
6. Remove the pull tab at bottom of the Study Buddy™ before playing.
7. Secure the Velcro™ closure.



QUICK START

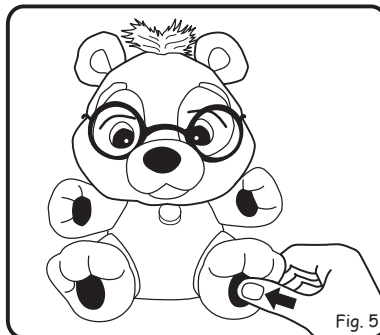
1. Turn your Study Buddy™ on by pressing its left rear paw. (Fig. 5)
2. When your Study Buddy™ wakes up, greet him with any of the following phrases:

Hello
I love you.
Tell me a joke.

How are you?
You're cute.
Let's play.

What's your name?
Tell me my fortune.
Good-bye, Koby™.

Your Study Buddy™ will respond in different ways at different times.



QUICK START (con't)

PLEASE NOTE

- If you say, "Good-bye, Koby™," Koby™ will go into sleep mode and you will need to press his paw again to wake him up.
 - If Koby™ doesn't understand you, he'll say one of the following to get you to repeat your response.
 - My fluffy ears are playing tricks on me.
 - I'm sorry, I missed that.
 - Oops! I could BEAR-ly hear you.
3. There is no response from you after around 5 seconds or you can say "Let's play" for choosing below game. He'll then ask you if you want to play and give you a list of things to do. When he mentions one you like, say, "Yes", "Okay" or "Sure" and he'll start the game. You can say "No" to choose other game. The choices are:
- Rhyme It
 - Alphabet Hunt
 - What's That Sound?
 - Storyteller
 - Jokes

NOTE: There are many more words your Study Buddy™ will recognize when playing different activities. EXAMPLE: In the "What's That Sound" game, when your Study Buddy™ asks you if a sound is heard in the "jungle" or the "city" and you say either of those two words, he'll recognize them.

4. Study Buddy™ may have several different replies to the same question, will move his mouth when talking, and will blink his eyes from time to time.
5. When you are done playing with Study Buddy™ tell him "Good-Bye Koby™ " and he'll let you know he's going to go to sleep.

NOTE

If Study Buddy™ hears no conversation for awhile he will take a nap. When there is silence:

- After a few seconds he'll try to get you to play with him.
- After a few more seconds, he'll let you know he might go to sleep.
- After another pause, he'll let you know he's going to sleep and he'll do so. (To wake him up once he's asleep, press his paw again.)

NOTE:

If you are not going to play with Study Buddy™ Koby™ for awhile, turn the ON/OFF switch on the bottom to the OFF position to save battery power.

If you are not going to play with him for quite some time, remove the batteries to avoid leakage and damage to the unit.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

To clean your Study Buddy™, brush it with a cloth or soft brush to loosen any dirt. Then use a lightly damp cloth to remove any stains.

- DO NOT PUT YOUR STUDY BUDDY™ IN THE WASHING MACHINE.
- DO NOT USE DETERGENT OR STAIN REMOVERS ON YOUR STUDY BUDDY™.
- DO NOT SUBMERGE YOUR STUDY BUDDY™ IN WATER.
- DO NOT EXPOSE YOUR STUDY BUDDY™ TO MOISTURE OF ANY KIND EXCEPT A DAMP CLOTH FOR CLEANING THE OUTER COVERING.
- WIPE DIRT OFF IMMEDIATELY TO PREVENT STAINS.
- IF THE STUDY BUDDY™ GETS WET, REMOVE BATTERIES IMMEDIATELY AND LET THE STUDY BUDDY™ AIR DRY.
- DO NOT PUT YOUR STUDY BUDDY™ INTO THE DRYER OR SUBJECT IT TO HEAT OF ANY KIND.
- REPLACE BATTERIES ONLY WHEN STUDY BUDDY™ IS COMPLETELY DRY.

HELP HINTS

- Keep background noise low - for best results play with Study Buddy™ in a quiet room.
- For best performance, you should face Study Buddy™ directly when play with it.
- Talk in a normal tone of voice, the way that you would talk to a friend. Pronounce all the syllables of each word clearly.
- Speak loudly and clearly when talking with Study Buddy™ for its recognize and response.
- If mouth or eyes motions becomes slow and the voice becomes weak/low, replace the designated AA batteries with fresh alkaline batteries.
- If you do not plan on playing with your Study Buddy™ for long periods of time, be sure to turn it OFF.
- If Study Buddy™ begins to function improperly, switch the ON/OFF switch to the "OFF" position, and then move back to the "ON" position.

SAFE BATTERY PRECAUTIONS

1. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged;
2. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged;
3. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision;
4. Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed;
5. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used;
6. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity;
7. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy;
8. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited;
9. Do not dispose of the batteries in fire, batteries may leak or explode;
10. Batteries should be replaced by adult;
11. Use alkaline batteries for better performance;
12. Batteries included are for in store demonstration only. Please change batteries when you take the product home before playing.
